

TOUCHSCREEN WITH ACCESS NX RACK AND MULTIRACK

Many ACCESS users may want the option for a non-Web Based Interface to use with their ACCESS NX Rack and MultiRack units. For example, the ACCESS NX Rack fits well within a van's remote rack, but using a Web-Based User Interface is inconvenient in this environment. By using a mobile-style touchscreen monitor, a console user interface can be presented with touch functionality. The model that has been successfully tested by Comrex for use with NX and MultiRack functionality is the Toguard WR952, which is operated by touching the screen with a finger or a stylus.



Note that while using the Toguard WR952:

- 1) Connection between the ACCESS NX Rack/MultiRack and Toguard WR952 is established with an HDMI connection.
- 2) If you need to enter characters in to the system, a separate USB keyboard will need to be attached, however, a future firmware update may eliminate this requirement.
- 3) The Toguard WR952 is available through online stores inside and outside of the U.S.A.
